

COVID-19: PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

DEAR FAMILIES AND VISITORS,

As we continue to operate our service, we require you to observe the following guidelines which we implement as precautionary measures in the interest of the health and wellbeing of our children, families and educators and in an attempt to support the community efforts in containing the spread of the Coronavirus / reduce exposure to it as best we can:

1. If you have recently returned from Mainland China, Iran, the Republic of Korea or Italy, you are not permitted to enter until you have observed a 14 day period of self-isolation from the date of your departure.
2. If you have returned from overseas on or after 16 March 2020, you are not permitted to enter until you have observed a 14 day period of self-isolation from the date of your arrival in Australia.
3. If you are unwell and/or have developed a fever, a cough, sore throat or shortness of breath, please do not enter.
4. If you are a contractor or supplier, please report to the Centre Director/Responsible Person, limit your direct contact with other people inside the building and apply appropriate social distancing routines as you move around the centre.
Again, please do not enter the building if 1), 2) or 3) apply.
5. As you enter, please use the hand sanitisers which are made available close to the check-in kiosks.
6. If you drop off or pick up a child, please take your child to the children's bathroom to wash hands with water and soap for 20 seconds and dry your hands.
7. Centre tours for interested families, Open Haus events, excursions and incursions are suspended until further notice.
8. Cover your sneeze or cough with your elbow or with tissue.
9. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth, and refrain from shaking other people's hands.
10. Our educators will be implementing health exclusion policies as always, and we will be grateful for our families' support and full cooperation.
